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Dairy Entry Requirements

1. Health Certification
2. Labelling Requirements (Attached filed: Food Labelling & Advertisement)

**For dairy products -**

Health Certification:

- a. with the following information:
  - i) Description of the products including brand name and nature of product;
  - ii) Quantity in the appropriate unit;
  - iii) Lot identifier and date of production;
  - iv) Name and address of the manufacturer or the processing establishment
  - v) Name and address of the importer or consignee
  - vi) Name and address of the exporter or consignor
  - vii) Country of dispatch
  - viii) Country of destination
- b. FMD free countries
  - i) Submission of health certificate (every consignment) that must contain the following attestation by the relevant competent authority of the exporting country
    - i. Products are produced using milk ingredients originating from FMD countries

**For infant formula (age 0 – 12 months)**

The import requirements for infant formula, and follow-on formula (age 0-12 months) are as follows:

- (a) Submission of documentary proof (one time submission) that the imported infant formulas are manufactured in a premise regulated by the competent authority (e.g. certified true copy of the manufacturer's licence)
- (b) FMD Free countries  
Submission of health certificate (every consignment) that must contain the following attestation by the relevant competent authority of the exporting country
  - a. Products are produced using milk ingredients originating from FMD free countries
  - b. Liquid milk used is pasteurized by heating at a min 72 degree celcius for a minimum 15 secs or an equivalent process
- (c) The health certificate should include the following information:
  - a. Description of the products including brand name and nature of product;
  - b. Quantity in appropriate units;
  - c. Lot identifier and date of production;
  - d. Name and address of the manufacturer or the processing establishment
  - e. Name and address of the importer or consignee;
  - f. Name and address of the exporter or consignee;
  - g. Country of dispatch
  - h. Country of destination
- (d) Submission of health certificate or manufacturer's quality control (QC) reports on chemical and microbiological test once every 6 months:
